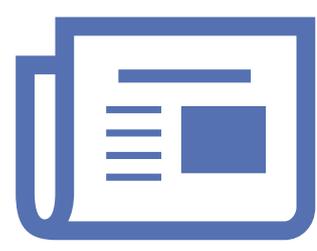

## NEW CAMPUS, NEW PROGRAMS, AND A NEW PHASE IN BTU'S GROWTH



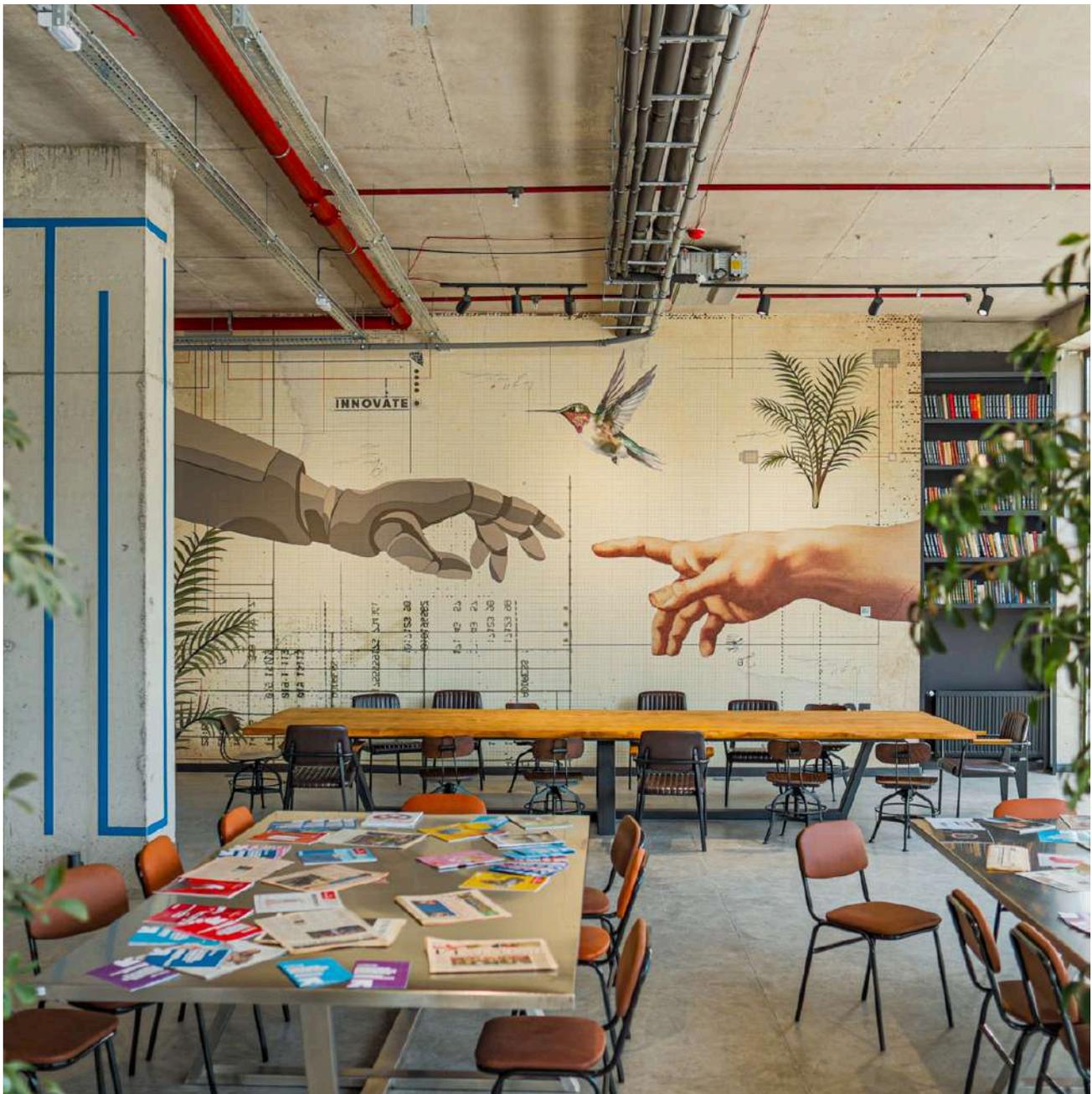

**Georgia's leading international pharmaceutical company reinforces its commitment to public health.**

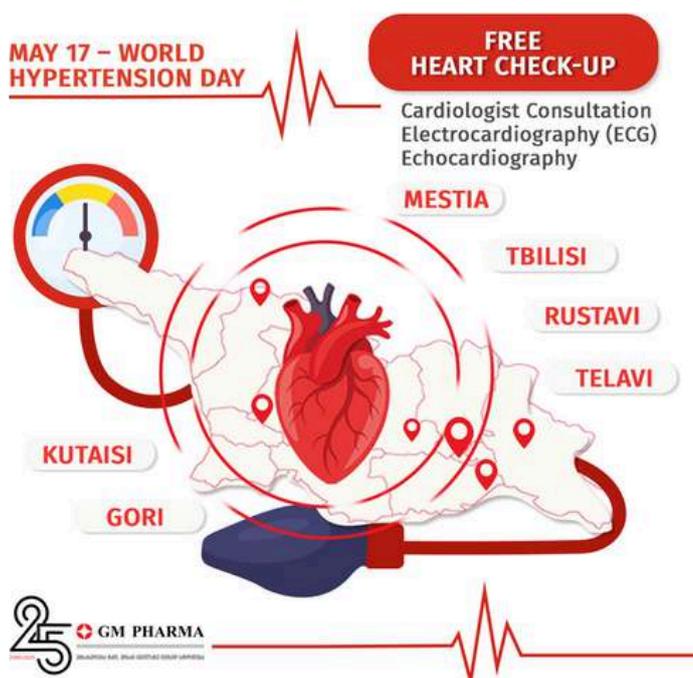

### About World Hypertension Day

World Hypertension Day, established in 2005 by the World Hypertension League (WHL), is a global initiative aimed at raising awareness about high blood pressure – a major risk factor for heart disease and stroke. Globally, hypertension affects more than one billion people, many of whom are unaware they have the condition. The campaign seeks to educate the public about the dangers of untreated high blood pressure, stressing the need for regular monitoring and healthy lifestyle choices. Early detection is critical, given that hypertension often presents no symptoms until it leads to severe complications.

### GM PHARMA's Commitment and Campaign Activities

Each year, GM PHARMA actively supports World Hypertension Day by organizing free medical screenings and consultations. The company's efforts aim to raise public awareness, encourage early diagnosis, and prevent complications related to hypertension. This year's campaign was carried out in several phases across Georgia, in collaboration with partner clinics. Screenings have already taken place in Rustavi, Telavi, Kutaisi, Mestia, and Gori. 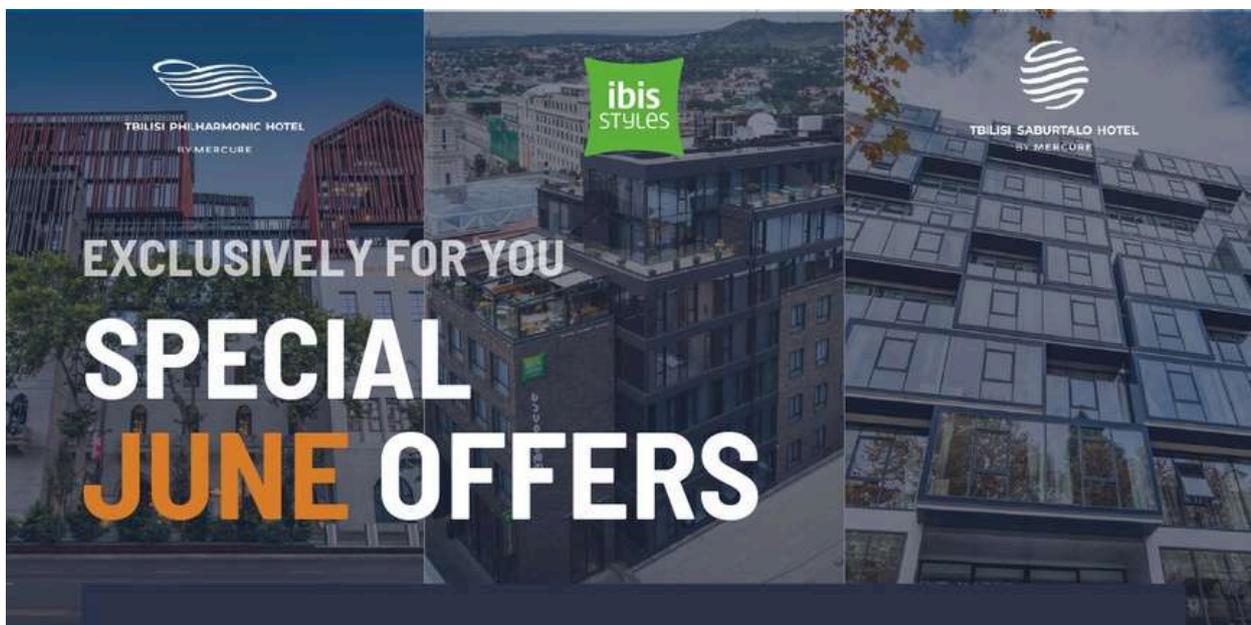
